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INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMMITTEE

Committee Responsibilities

1. There shall be Ritual Competition at each Annual Session of the Grand Bethel.
2. Detailed rules, entry forms, and scoring sheets for the Ritual Competitions are on file in and available from the Grand Secretary's office. They are also available on-line at www.caiojd.org.
3. Diagrams and/or instructions for all floor work shall be provided after the Grand Bethel walk-through and prior to the day of competition.
4. Any allowed deviation from the rules shall be included with the initial announcement.
5. Proposed costs for Ritual Competition shall be submitted to the Grand Bethel Board of Directors by September 15 for approval and inclusion in the budget of the Grand Bethel.
6. The due date for submitting the number of medallions and certificates required for Ritual Competition shall be no later than May 15.
7. A member of the competition committee shall be in attendance at all times and at all sessions of the competition to assure compliance with all rules. If rules are not followed, the committee member[s] shall be empowered to deduct points as stipulated in the competition rules.
8. An adult eligible to attend Bethel meetings shall be stationed at each door of the room in which the Ritual Competitions are held. He/she shall determine the eligibility of all side liners.
9. The contests shall be conducted in an atmosphere similar to a Bethel meeting. The ONLY open Rituals in the room shall be those used by the persons appointed to do the scoring for memory work and the prompter. NO PICTURES may be taken in the competition room.
10. Should facilities and finances be available, an endeavor should be made to provide judging rooms that will accommodate side liners in all competition rooms. Side liners will be limited to the number of chairs already set up on the side lines. Side liners may enter or leave the room only during announced breaks.

RULES FOR JUDGING RITUAL COMPETITION

1. Three judges will be used in each aspect of judging: appearance, memory work, and poise and delivery. One judge per room shall be on the current list of CAVs provided by the Executive Manager. Appearance judges shall all be female on the current list of CAVs provided by the Executive Manager. Judges and prompters shall be interested adults who are eligible to attend a Bethel meeting and who can honestly and impartially judge the competition. The same set of judges shall judge an entire Division.

BETHEL LEVEL: Judges are to be appointed by the Bethel Guardian Council. A Bethel Daughter may be the Prompter.

ASSOCIATION AND GRAND BETHEL LEVELS: Judges shall be appointed by the Association and Grand Bethel Ritual Committees.

2. The APPEARANCE judges shall allow 1/8 inch on each side of a listed measurement [1/4 inch in total] before deducting points. *They shall consult and award a single score for each judged detail.* Printed points shall **NOT** be further subdivided.
3. Off-body robe judging may be used at the discretion of the competition chairman.
4. Judges shall **NOT** compile scores. Tabulators shall receive the judges' completed scoring sheets and tally the points as follows:
 - a. The Poise and Delivery sheets shall be tallied individually and then added together. The result shall be divided by the number of judges for Poise and Delivery.
 - b. The single Appearance score [see #2 above] shall be added to the Poise and Delivery Score.
 - c. Memory Work scores shall be tallied individually and then added together. The result shall be divided by the number of judges for Memory Work. The result shall be subtracted from the Poise and Delivery/Appearance score. This is the final score.
 - d. Highest possible mark is 100. Where there are several Daughters competing, adding machines and/or computers shall be used in compiling scores. Two [2] tapes and/or printouts shall be run for each set of score sheets; one [1] copy of the tabulated score must be included in the packet.
5. If desired, the judges may meet briefly with the contestants, individually or in a group, to put the girls at ease.

6. Schedule for contest on Association and Grand Bethel levels:
 - a. The number assigned each Daughter shall be used in all aspects of the contest.
 - b. Daughters shall be judged on personal appearance prior to or after saying the Ritual work in the competition room.
 - c. Daughters shall await their turn to compete in a separate room where they cannot hear the other contestants.

AWARDS

1. Certificates and/or awards may be given to Daughters competing on the Bethel and Association levels as determined by the individual Bethel or Association.
2. Certificates shall be given to Daughters taking part in the competition at the Grand Bethel competition.
3. **INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION**
Medallions shall be awarded for first, second and third place [if there is that number of competitors]. One ribbon may be given for Honorable Mention.
4. **TEAM COMPETITION**
Medallions shall be awarded for first, second and third place [if there is that number of competitors]. One ribbon may be given for Honorable Mention.
5. In the case of a tie, duplicate awards shall be given.
6. The name of the winners in each category shall be engraved on the Redwood Empire Guardian Council Association Perpetual Plaque in the Grand Secretary's office.

RULES FOR RITUAL COMPETITION

1. There shall be Ritual Competition at each Annual Session of the Grand Bethel.
2. Detailed rules, entry forms, and scoring sheets for the contests are on file in and available from the Grand Secretary's office. They are also available online at www.caiojd.org.
3. Each Bethel shall give the Daughters wishing to compete an opportunity to do their work before the Daughters and the Bethel Guardian Council at a Bethel meeting during Good of the Bethel.
4. Each Bethel shall hold an elimination contest, if necessary [except for Team Competition] at a Bethel meeting during Good of the Bethel.
5. Each Bethel may qualify two [2] Daughters per division for the Bethel Station and the Story of Job competition as entries at the Association level.
6. Names of each Bethel's winners are to be submitted to their Association Ritual Chairman by the Bethel Guardian. Bethels are to compete only in their Association.
7. Associations with five [5] or fewer Bethels may send one [1] Messenger Team and one [1] Story of Job contestant for each division to compete at the Grand Bethel level.

Associations with between five [5] and ten [10] Bethels in the Association may send two [2] Messenger Teams and two [2] Story of Job contestants for each division to compete at the Grand Bethel level.

Associations with more than ten [10] Bethels in the Association may send three [3] Messenger Teams and three [3] Story of Job contestants for each division to compete at the Grand Bethel level.

Each Association may qualify three [3] Daughters for each division as contestants in the Bethel Station competition at the Grand Bethel level.

8. A Bethel Daughter may compete as one [1] of the five [5] members of one [1] team and in one [1] individual Ritual competition at the Association level.

A team may list members from another team comprised from the same Bethel as alternates as long as the members do not compete [actually recite a Messenger lecture] on two [2] concurrent teams during the competition at Association level.

9. A minimum score of fifty [50] points must be obtained at the Association level in order to compete at the Grand Bethel level. A minimum score of fifty [50] points must be obtained at the Grand Bethel level in order to receive an award medallion.
10. Names of the Association winners and alternates shall be submitted to the Grand Bethel Ritual Contest chairman by May 1. Competitor and alternate names as submitted by Associations are finalized as of May 1.

RULES FOR ELIGIBILITY

1. Daughters shall be active members in good standing in their Bethel. An **active Majority Member is defined in Supreme, Supplemental Instruction No. 9 [SI 9]**.
 2. In competitions where categories are defined by age, **age will be determined as of the last day of the Annual Meeting of the Grand Bethel except in the case of Daughters who are 20 years of age and active members. [SI 9]**
 3. All Daughters must have passed their Proficiency Test prior to April 15.
 4. All Daughters participating in competition shall wear official regalia; no capes or crowns shall be worn.
 5. All instructions in the Ritual that apply to the chosen lecture are to be followed.
 6. Messenger Teams and alternates may be composed of Bethel Daughters from one [1] Bethel or a combination of Bethels within the Association **not to exceed seven [7] Daughters per team.**
- | Division A teams will include two [2] or fewer Daughters who have previously competed on a team at Grand Bethel.
- | Division B teams will include three [3] or more Daughters who have previously competed on a team at Grand Bethel.

BETHEL STATION COMPETITION

1. Age divisions **will be** based on the **age of the Daughter** on the last day of the Annual Meeting of the Grand Bethel and shall be as follows:

Division A – 10, 11 and 12 years of age

Division B – 13 and 14 years of age

Division C – 15 and 16 years of age

Division D – 17 and 18 years of age

Division E – 19 years of age to Majority [see clarification in #1 Rules for Eligibility]

2. The Ritual work to be used for the competition shall be selected by the Grand Guardian and announced in the #5 Grand Bethel letter in January. The rules and entry forms shall be included in the mailing or posted on the web-site www.caiojd.org.
3. Contestants must follow all rules for competition and eligibility.
4. Bethel Station competition participants will enter the room in an orderly manner, stand facing the poise and delivery judges, who shall be located east of the Altar, and give their assigned competition number after which they will be seated. Judging will begin when the Prompter instructs the Daughter to begin. When the Daughter has completed her recitation, the Prompter will excuse the Daughter and she will retire.
5. All entry forms shall be signed by the Bethel Guardian and sent to the Association's Ritual Chairman. Electronic signatures will be accepted. All Bethel Daughters must compete at the Association level in the proper age category.

MESSENGER TEAM COMPETITION

1. The Messenger Team may consist of seven [7] Daughters, any five [5] of whom may compete at any Messenger station in any level of competition.
2. Contestants must follow all rules for competition and eligibility.
3. Messenger Teams may be composed of Bethel Daughters from one [1] Bethel or a combination of Bethels within the Association **not to exceed seven [7] Daughters per team, per division.**

Messenger Team Division A shall include two [2] or fewer Daughters of the team who have previously competed on a team at Grand Bethel.

Messenger Team Division B shall include three [3] or more Daughters of the team who have previously competed on a team at Grand Bethel.

4. Each Bethel shall give the Daughters wishing to compete an opportunity to do their work before the Daughters and the Bethel Guardian Council at a Bethel meeting during Good of the Bethel.
5. All entry forms shall be signed by the Bethel Guardian and sent to the Association's Ritual Chairman. Five [5] Bethel Daughters must compete at the Association level.
6. Five [5] members of the Messenger Team who compete will give the initiatory work and the directions to the Guide and Marshal as applicable to their stations. The Prompter shall read the instructions of the Guide.
7. The Messenger Team will enter the room and take its positions in the semicircle in front of the Messengers' chairs. The First Messenger will give the assigned competition number before the team is seated. Judging will start when the Prompter instructs the team to begin and will end when the Fifth Messenger returns to her station and is seated. When the Team has completed its recitations, the Prompter will excuse the Team and the members will rise together and retire.

STORY OF JOB COMPETITION

1. The Story of Job Competition features one Daughter giving the five Messenger initiation parts as one continuous story. Instructions to the Guide are to be excluded.

2. Contestants must follow all rules for competition and eligibility.

3. Divisions shall be based on age, except when fewer than three [3] entries are submitted in a category. In such cases, the category with fewer than three [3] entries shall be combined with only the next one [1] higher age category. Categories will be:

Division A: 10 and 11 years of age

Division B: 12 years of age

Division C: 13 years of age

Division D: 14 years of age

Division E: 15 years of age

Division F: 16 years of age

Division G: 17 years of age

Division H: 18 years of age

Division I: 19 years of age to Majority [see clarification in #1, Rules of Eligibility]

4. Contestants must follow all rules for competition and eligibility.

5. All entry forms shall be signed by the Bethel Guardian and sent to the Association Ritual Contest Chairman. All Bethel Daughters must compete at the Association level in the proper age category.

6. Participants will enter the room in an orderly manner, standing west of the Altar facing the judges and give her assigned competition number. Judging will begin when the Prompter notifies the Daughter to start. When a Daughter has completed her recitation, the Prompter will excuse the Daughter and she will retire.
